LARGE-FLOWERING CLEMATIS

Clematis is a member of the Ranunculaceae (buttercup) family. The word is Greek and means "vine". The leaf stalk twines like a tendril and is responsible for giving support to the plant. The flowers are showy, having four to eight petal-like sepals (no true petals). Clematis are hardy plants (many are hardy to USDA zone 3) and can survive for 25 years or more. The large-flowered hybrids may have blooms ranging from 4 to 10 inches in diameter and as many as 100 blooms per plant in a season.

Elephant Ears

The Elephant Ear grows from large starchy roots in well-draining, preferable organic, moist soil. It can grow from 3 to 6 feet tall with heart-shaped leaves approximately 24" wide. The plant performs best in part shade. It is mainly used to create wide green borders along ponds or flower beds. It can also be grown in containers as a patio plant. These bulbs are hardy from zone 7 south. Available: February - June Planting: Outside, in the spring as soon as soil temperatures reach above 55°F.



Ways to use Clematis:

- Grow on fences & stone walls.
- Train to grow up a tree trunk, tree stumps and rock piles.
- Use as a ground cover
- Frame around porches and other entrances.
- Grow up unsightly utility & light poles.
- Screen unwanted views.
- Grow along with a climbing rose.
- Grow through shrubs of all kinds.
- Grow in a container on a trellis or other support.
- Grow as a cut flower or float flowers in a bowl.
- Clematis can be planted anytime the soil can be worked.
- Clematis require full sun to grow best (6+ hours direct sun per day) though some dappled shade during the heat of the day is beneficial.
- Clematis prefer their heads in the sun & their feet in the shade.**
